


Good Practice Guidance for Care Homes Aqueous cream wash chart When using this chart, write 'see Aqueous cream wash chart' on main MAR. Instructions for use: Mix a small amount of aqueous cream in the palm of the gloved hand (about half to one teaspoonful) with a little warm water, and spread it over damp or dry skin. Rinse well and pat the skin dry, but do not rub. If using whilst showering/bathing the aqueous cream can be rubbed into the skin and showered or washed off in the bath.

Additional notes: DO NOT leave aqueous cream on the skin. DO NOT use as a moisturiser.
