Buprenorphine	Temgesic®	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Buprenorphine and Temazepam are required to be stored in a CD cupboard and as good practice care homes should record them in the CD register Other schedule 3 controlled drugs do not need CD storage or recorded in the CD register. <p>***Exempt from storage and record keeping – store and record as with “non CDs”</p>
